Watching television is one of the most common ways to 3 time. In the United States, 4 show that 95% of all homes have at least one television. In fact, more people have televisions than telephones or indoor toilets. Television began to be a part of family life in the early 1950s. At that time, one in fifteen homes had a television. By the end of that 5 the statistic jumped to one in five homes. Nowadays, the television is turned on an average of seven hours per day. People view TV about two and a half hours to five hours a day. It is rather shocking to know that by the time a person graduates from high school, he will have spent more time in front of the TV than he will have in the classroom. People who are against TV say that people, especially children, are exposed to an unnecessary 6 of violence. Police shows and action dramas that have a lot of killing may teach us to be 7 to true violence. Another reason to be wary of TV is the way family dramas 8 people.
