Dear Kazuhiro -

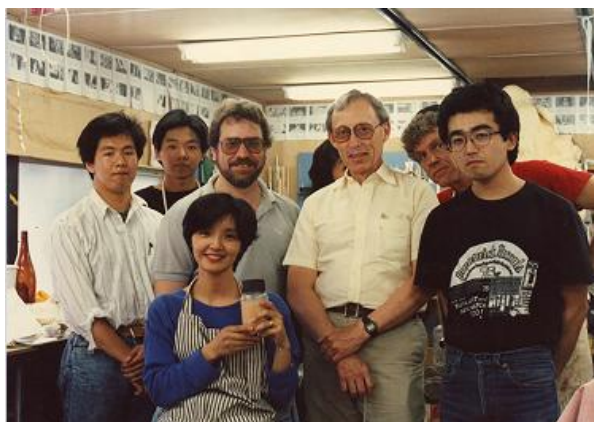
