Part 1	naked	not wearing any clothes <OALD>
	eel	a long thin fish that looks like a snake and can be eaten <LDOCE>
	actually	used to emphasize the real or exact truth of a situation, rather than what people may think <LDOCE>
	mood	the way you are feeling at a particular time <OALD>
	upside	the upper part or surface
	humor	the quality in something that makes it funny; the ability to laugh at things that are funny <OALD>
Part 2	printmaker	an artist who prints pictures or designs <OALD>
	sight	the act of seeing something <LDOCE>
	realistic	representing things as they are in real life <OALD>
	normal	usual, typical, or expected <LDOCE>
	unreal	not related to reality <OALD>

	unnatural	different from what you would normally expect <LDOCE>
	confusing	difficult to understand; not clear <OALD>
	waterfall	a place where water from a river or stream falls down over a cliff or rock <LDOCE>
	bottom	the lowest part of something <OALD>
	relativity	the state of being relative and only able to be judged when compared with something else <OALD>
	saying	a well-known short statement that expresses an idea most people believe is true and wise <LDOCE>
Part 3	illegal	not allowed by the law <LDOCE>
	parking	the act of stopping a vehicle at a place and leaving it there for a period of time <OALD>
	irritating	annoying, especially because of something somebody continuously does or something that continuously happens <OALD>
	experiment	a process in which you test a new idea or method to see if it is useful or effective <LDOCE>
	sidewalk	a flat part at the side of a road for people to walk on <OALD>
	ordinary	average, common, or usual, not different or special <LDOCE>

flat	smooth and level, without raised or hollow areas, and not sloping or curving <LDOCE>
nearby	not far away <LDOCE>
suddenly	quickly and unexpectedly <OALD>
hopeful	believing that something you want will happen <OALD>
