## Tips for Expression



- 2. 過去のことについて、現在の時点で  $[\sim$ だった [した]にちがいない  $[\sim$ だった [した]かもしれない]」と推量する場合は $\{$ must[may] have +過去分詞 $\}$ の形を用いる  $(\rightarrow ⑤)$ .
