Let's speak about...

〈英語での導入例〉

What types of activity do you enjoy doing? Do you like to spend your time outside, or do you prefer to do things indoors? Think of some examples of outdoor activities. Do you enjoy fishing or hiking? What about indoor activities? Do you like reading, listening to music, or playing an instrument? Today we're going to read a conversation between Meg and Ken. They're talking about what they did last weekend.
