Step 3 Refute the Cons Team's points.

List facts and opinions that can be used to refute the Cons Team's points.

Ex. As Japan belongs to the international community, we have to support not only people who are suffering in Japan but also people who are suffering in developing countries.

Example Responses to Start the Refutation

*refutation 反論



It sounds correct, but <u>as Japan belongs to the international</u> <u>society</u>, we have to <u>support</u> not only people who are <u>suffering in Japan but also people who are suffering in</u> <u>developing countries</u>.

<Expression Hints>

It sounds correct, but ... それは正しく思えますが, … It may be true in a sense, but ... それはある意味では正しいですが, …

Ex. It is difficult to support all the people who are suffering from poverty. Since money is limited, Japan does not need to give more money..

Example Responses to Start the Refutation *refutation 反論



It sounds correct, but <u>it is difficult to support all the</u> <u>people who are suffering from poverty.</u> Since money is <u>limited</u>, Japan does not need to give more money.

<Expression Hints>

It sounds correct, but ... それは正しく思えますが, … It may be true in a sense, but ... それはある意味では正しいですが, …
