- 1) What is the job of hospital facility dogs?
 - (It is) Giving emotional support to children.
- 2) Who do hospital facility dogs support?
 - (They support) Children.
- 3) What do the children in hospital experience?

- 4) What do the children suffer from?
 - They suffer from pain and stress.
- 5) How do hospital facility dogs comfort the children?
 - They comfort the children by staying with them.
- 6) Who do the handlers work with?

- 7) Who do the handlers take care of?
 - They take care of the facility dogs.
- 8) Who are the handlers always together with?
 - (They are (always) together with) The facility dogs.
- 9) Are the handlers with facility dogs at home?
 - Yes, they are.

- 1) Do facility dogs have to be clean?
 - Yes, they do.
- 2) Why do facility dogs have to be clean?
 - Because they work in a hospital.

- 3) What do the handlers do to keep the facility dogs clean?
 - They brush the dogs' hair and teeth carefully every morning.
- 4) When do the handlers brush the dogs' hair and teeth?
 - (They do it) In the morning.
- 5) Should the handlers always be happy?
 - Yes, they should.
- 6) Why do facility dogs feel the same when their handlers are sad or nervous?
 - Because they are very sensitive.
- 7) What happens to facility dogs when their handlers are sad or nervous?
 - They may feel the same, and cannot enjoy working.
- 8) What is the problem when the facility dogs feel sad or nervous?
 - They cannot enjoy working.
- 9) Are the handlers and facility dogs together twenty-four seven?
 - Yes, they are.
- 10) Why do the handlers and facility dogs have such a strong bond?
 - Because they are together twenty-four seven.
- 11) What are the important things for the handlers? List three.
 - They should keep facility dogs clean.
 - They should always be happy.
 - They should understand the dogs.
